





Education Program: MBSK, Balubari, Dinapur has been implementing the Literacy program by establishing primary school named Hazrat Ma Fatema (R) with own initiatives for ensuring participation of poor student in education. The organization has been implementing the preprimary schooling at Hazrat Ma Fatema (R) primary school and then primary schooling. Children of poor and marginal people are student of the school and the school located at Sheikhpura. Till 1440 students have been completed course of Primary schooling and subsequently many of them continuing their study. At present the numbers of the students are 126. The age ranges of learners are 4-12 years. Every year a large number of students enrolled for education. MBSK afford expenditure of Books, Khata, Paper, pen and school dress for the student and class-I, II, III & IV are running. As per class routine 4 days learning, 2 days poem, rhymes, general knowledge and game has to be arranged for recreation. Examination held twice in a year. In every year MBSK arranged 03 mothers gathering, student household visit one time in each month, arrange different function, annual sports and prize giving ceremony. After end of the course the student goes to other school for education in higher class. The School also entitled education of Arabic and Sohih Holy Quran for the different aged people. The people of the area are very gladly such education and it is running successfully.

2. Handicraft and Tailoring Project:

Income generation activities under Integrated Agriculture unit (Agri. Fisheries and Livestock) are implementing through demonstration plot. Beyond these to provide quality services organized technology-based training and exposure visit for staff skill development.

Integrated Agriculture Unit (Agriculture, Fishery & Livestock) 2023-2024A achievement:

Agriculture Unit Activities:

High Value Crop Cultivation Utilizing Environment Friendly Mulching Paper: It is new method to produce high value vegetable through utilizing mulching paper. There were target to establish 10 demonstration using environment friendly mulching paper in 2023-24 FY and implemented mentioned targeted 10 demo plot. Under this demo each members were have gotten a mulching paper roll, Organic and chemical fertilizer and qualitative high yielding vegetable seeds.

High Yielding New Variety Rice Production: There were target to establish of high yielding new variety disaffected atmosphere tolerance special character rice production like (in Boro season BRRI-81, 89, 92& 104 and in Ammon season BRRI-75, 90 and Bina 17). There were Target 10 and achieved 10 demo plot in the FY 2023-24, as such total up to the date 109 demo implemented. The selected each farmer were get 10 KGs quality seed of rice, fertilizer and labor & irrigation ets. support (beyond seeds) @ TK 1350/- from the project.

Disaffected Atmosphere Tolerance and Especial character new variety crop introduction: New variety vegetable like-Broccoli, red cabbage, yellow and red cauliflower introduced in the respective field in FY 2023-24, and total 12 such demonstration implemented & cumulative 113 plots. As such each farmer have gotten quality seed/ saplings, fertilizer and irrigation support @ TK. 1350/.

Quality Rice seed Production and Preservation Technology: During FY 2023-24 established 20 rice seed production plot and provide 5 KGs quality rice seeds (BRRI-81), organic & chemical fertilizer, for seed preservation plastic dram, mud jar, tin dram, polyethylene and candle to each farmer.

Improve cropping pattern to increase the crop intensity: To increase the crop intensity like instead of 2 crops to 3 & 3 to 4 crops with utilizing modern cropping pattern established 04 demonstration in 2023-24 and total 21 cumulative demonstration implemented now on. Each farmer were get quality rice seeds and TK. 2500/- for organic & chemical fertilizer & others purpose.

Multi-Layer Vegetable and Fruits gardening to secure Family Nutrition: To secure the family nutrition implemented 02 multi-layer vegetable and fruits garden in homestead yard were performed as per target during the FY 2023-24. Provided quality vegetable seeds, fruits sapling, fertilizer to each farmer and up to now on cumulative total 221 demo were executed.

Inter cropping to Increase Productivity: There were target to establish 04 inter cropping pattern to increase productivity, as such done the activities accordingly in FY 2023-24. Each farmer was got quality seed & saplings, and for fertilizer and irrigation purpose provided financial support also.

Development of Entrepreneurship for High Value Fruits Production: There were target to establish 04 high value fruits garden as such done the activities accordingly in FY 2022-23. Each farmer was got quality saplings, land preparation, plantation, labor, bamboo pillar, fertilizer, pesticide, & irrigation purpose and cumulative demo were implemented 13.

Summer Season Watermelon Cultivation: In FY 2023-24 established targeted 02 summer season watermelon demonstration in working area and under this plot provided cash support to each farmer like- quality saplings of fruits, land preparation, labor cost, fertilizer, irrigation etc. purpose of costing TK.2500/- to each participant and up to now on total 14 demo were established.

Summer Season Tomato Cultivation: In FY 2023-24 established targeted 02 summer season tomato demonstration in working area and under this plot provided cash support to each farmer like- quality saplings of tomato, land preparation, labor cost, fertilizer, irrigation etc. purpose of costing TK.2500/- to each participant and up to now on total 02 demo were established.

Zinger Cultivation: There were target to establish of high value spice crop production and as such implemented 02 demonstration in FY 2023-24(Zinger). The selected each farmer got zinger seed, land preparation, labor, fertilizer, irrigation including all of costing purpose @ TK 600/from the project.

Establish Half Cluster to Produce Safe Vegetable: During the reporting year there were target to establish 15 demonstrations to make half cluster of vegetable in working area and as such developed 15 demo of different high value vegetable like- Tomato 08 plot, vegetable -07 plot, each farmers were get support of seeds, land preparation, fertilizer purchase, irrigation, pesticide & others.

Establish Safe Vegetable Sale Center in Local Market: There was target to establish 01 safe vegetable sell center and according established the same in Bahadur Bazar, Dinajpur town

market and from the program provided different materials like- one wooden Chowki, digital scale, plastic cared, bamboo busket /Tukri etc. amounting of support TK. 10,000/-. The objective of the demo is to sale safe vegetable by the producer with reasonable price and have create scope to buy safe product for consumers. In such way encourage to produce safe product by the farmers and as well betterment of human health.

Trico-Compost production to protect the soil health: Provide support to the farmers with establishing 01 demonstration plot in FY 2023-24, as such cumulative achievement are 87, each Trico-compost holder members have gotten 1000 g.m. Trico-drama powder, 20 CI sheet/tin to make shade, bricks to prepared 10 chamber/ pit and ensure the compost pit.

Rice Cultivation with following Somoloy method: This is a new concept to cultivate rice in a field together with at least 50 farmers. The method is used to minimize the labor crisis through using agricultural machineries. Under this method bulk number of farmers will cultivate the rice at a time with using machineries for plantation, harvesting and others activities, as such reduced the production cost. During the reporting year 2023-24 implemented 01 Somoloya method cultivation where includes 50 farmers and use BRRI- 81 rice variety.

Upazila Planning and coordination meeting: Upazila level planning and coordination meeting organized on 09 November 2023 under the management of MBSK Integrated Agriculture Units (IAU) supported by PKSF. Discussion was made about the plan/target of various demonstration plan on Agri. Fish & Livestock unit, technology and technical service (new variety crop, training, follow-up on technical issue, field day arrangement etc), the details were discussed about implementation method and also anticipation of support from Government concern line departments, thus make technical planning at the beginning of the year. In the meeting were attended Upazila Agriculture Officer, Upazila Fisheries Officer, Upazila Livestock Officer, research Officer, Agri. material businessman and success demo farmer of 03 units. Necessary suggestions were seek from the respective Government Officers in regards to implement the technology at field level.

Observation of National Safe Food Day: There are no alternative of safe food to ensure healthy manner of human being. Safe food is one of the essential elements for health, considering the issue the National safe food day observed with includes all categories people of the society. As part to aware the much people government declared the National safe food day on 02 February and accordingly observed the National safe food day 3 rd time in the area attended by Upazila Agriculture Officer, MBSK head office staff, Focal person, local elites, School/College teacher, project staff & others of the community at least were 70-80 participants. The day was observed followed by rally with colorful banner/festoon, essay competition on Safe food (what is safe food, production of safe food, why it is necessary etc.) among high (Godagri)school level students, quiz competition etc. were done and given prize to the winners and for others student common prize to all.

Agriculture Consultation Center: Organized Agriculture consultation center were done at field level under Agri, units aiming to deliver technical knowledge and strengthen the ongoing initiative where included farmers, members etc. Discussion was made on Agricultural various issue like- new variety, technology, modern agriculture for crop production, introduction of modern equipment, control measure of insect, use of chemical fertilizer and pesticide etc. Upazila Agriculture Officer, was attended as facilitator in the consultation center.

Training: Organized 03Training courses on agriculture and each one course for 02 days, during the FY 2023-24 conducted all 04 courses with imparted of selected demo participants. Total 100 participants were received the said training in different date & venue and each course attended 25 participants and tropics were on modern Agriculture technology. The external resource person were Upazila Agriculture Officer Sadar. Dinajpur.

Field Day:

Field Day (Agriculture Unit): Mohila Bohumukhi Shikkha Kendra (MBSK) organized yield day under Agriculture unit in 2023-24, 75 members were attended in each session and unit officials, branch manager & other staff. The above field days were arranged in different places in working area, where made specimen of fish.

Fisheries Unit:

There are numbers of activities were implemented in 2023-24 under Fisheries unit and these are as follows;-

G-3 Rui Fish Cultivation: During the reporting year G-3 Rui culture target were 15 achievement 15 & cumulative achievement 15, replication are 12. Each member was goet 20 KGs G-3 Rui fish ling.

Semi-intensive Method Local Sing, Magur and Carp mix culture: The target was 15 demonstration of local Sing, Magur and Carp mix culture and perform in the field 15demo & aggregate achievement are 155. The project support were 3500 nos. sing fish-ling to each one.

Semi-intensive Method Carp Fattening: Carp fattening demo establishment target were 05 and performed 05, as such cumulative achievement are-92 and from the program given 30 kgs carp variety fish ling to each i.e. 150 KGs to all 05 participants.

High value Fish Chitol and Carp mix culture: The target was of High value fish Chitol and Carp mix culture 05 and done achievement 05, cumulative achievement are 55. The project provided 100 pieces of Chitol fishing to each as such total 500 pieces Chitil fish ling given to all.

High Value Fish culture in Tank: Now a days fish culture using in tank almost new in the locality and from the project encouraging to practicing, thus the target were-04 and perform -03 demo in reporting FY, cumulative achievement is 37 and replication are -24. Those who have no space for pond they can also culture fish in tank in homestead yard. The project spend 18,000/for each and total TK. 54,000/-.

Marketing and Cultivation of Ornamental Fish: As per target of FY 2023-24, cultivation of ornamental fish 03 demonstration were established accordingly of which cumulative are 25, replication 01 and each of the participants were get support from project various ornamental brood 350 nos. and total 1050 brood to all 03 participants.

Off Flavor free Pangash Cultivation: There were target in 2023-24 to establish 15 demonstrations as such performed the said target consequently performed and cumulative 25 demo. Each of the participants were get 16 KGs pangash fish lings and total 80 KGs fish lings provided to all 05 participants.

Fish ling Carrying with Oxygenated Van: During the reporting year 2023-24 there is a target to implement oxygenated van by which will carry the fish ling to make available the alive fish ling to the pond holder, besides also carry the alive fish to the market place to maximum profit. As per target provided a oxygenated van to a member with costing TK. 3500/-.

Innovative Fish relevant Activities (Ready to Cook): During the reporting year 2023-24 there is a target for Innovative Fish relevant Activities, as such provided support to a member make ready to cook fish, thus provided the said demo along with necessary input support amounting to TK. 40,000/-.

Training:

Organized 04 Training courses on fish culture and each one course for 02 days, during the FY 2023-24 conducted all 04 courses with imparted of selected demo participants. Total 100 participants were received the said training in different date & venue and each course attended 25 participants and tropics were on modern fish culture technology. The external resource person were Upazila Fisheries officer, Dist. Fisheries officer, and teacher of HSTU Basherhat Dinajpur.

Field Day:

Field Day (Fisheries Unit): Mohila Bohumukhi Shikkha Kendra (MBSK) organized 06 Nos. field day under Fisheries unit in 2023-24, total 450 members were attended and unit officials, branch manager & other staff. The above 06 field days were arranged in different places in working area, where made specimen of fish.

Fish Culture Service and Consultation Centre:

Fish culture service and consultation center arranged quarterly basis and total 01 program were performed and 50 participants were attended of fish culture member. discussion was made on modern technology of fish culture

Market Linkage Workshop:

MBSK organized a market linkage workshop under Fisheries unit that held at MBSK head office-based hall room where participated Fish Arotder, paiker, retailer, feed seller, pond owners (fish farmer) and MBSK concern staff members. The resource facilitator was Dist. Fisheries officer and Sadar upazila Fisheries officer, discussion was made on market management, fresh fish preservation technique, feed price, fish price/rate, market linkage and future strategy for marketing etc.

Livestock Unit:

There are numbers of activities were executed in 2023-24 under Livestock unit and these are as follows;-

Castrated Goat Fattening with Intensive Care:

There were 15 targets for castrated goat fattening with intensive care and accordingly perform all 15 demo in FY 2023-24 and under this scheme each participants have gotten feed of amounting TK. 3250/-, grass cutting of TK. 50/-, vitamin, mineral & register of TK. 200 and TK. 2000/- for trellis/ "macha" and signboard.

Cow Rearing with Standard Management:

In reporting year 2023-24 Cow rearing with standard management target were 15 and as such implemented 15 demon in the field with selection of appropriate participants following the specific criteria. Cumulative achievement is 192 and replication are-68. Each of the participant were get different materials of amounting to TK. 5000/-.

Establishment of Buck Center:

There were activities to establish 10 Buck Center and accordingly done this work, cumulative 115 demo implemented and provided 02 buck, for bamboo made trellis/ "macha" TK. 1200/-, &

TK. 300 for signboard & register to every selected participants. Cumulative achievement is -115 and replication is -37.

Broiler Type Pekin Duck Rearing:

Broiler type pakin duck rearing target were 20 and done the task 20 in reporting FY, Cumulative achievement are 202 and replication are-34 nos. Under this item each participants got 50 pakin duckling, shade repairing purpose TK. 1500/-, vaccine & medicine cost 100/-, feed & antiseptic purpose 2500/- and TK.400/- for signboard & register.

Production of Native Chicken Parent stock with intensive free ranging method: As per target of FY 2023-24 performed the 03 demo on Native chicken parent stock production with intensive free ranging method and replication were 02. Under the scheme given 100 native chicks and shade repairing cost 5500/-, nest cost 1000/-, free ranging area purpose 1000/-, vaccine purpose 100/-, feed & disinfectant purpose 400/- signboard & register 500/-. As such total 11,500/- grant support to each participant from the project.

Native Chicken Rearing with maintaining Especial Housing: Native chicken rearing with maintaining especial housing target were 25 and performed 25 demos in FY 2023-24. the cumulative achievement are 115 up to now on and replication are 15, under this demo given different materials like- shelter/house, next, feed, signboard, register etc. of amounting to TK 6500/- for each participant.

Pigeon Culture following combined method (Intensive & semi-intensive): Pigeon culture through combined method (intensive & semi-intensive) target were 05 nos. and implemented 03 demo in the field and up to now on total 07 demo implemented. A total support of 8000/provided from the project for each & every participant.

Sonali Bird rearing with Maintaining bio-security Measure: There were target to implement 15 demo of Sonali hen rearing with maintaining bio-security measurement in FY 2023-24 and as such done the targeted activities according. The cumulative achievement are 112 demo and replication are 26 Nos and in reporting year every participants were get 300 chicks including other materials of amounting TK. 9000/-.

Feed Processing and marketing of Pet Animal: Two demos were established 03 Feed processing and marketing center in FY 2023-24 under Integrated Agriculture Unit(IAU) with the support of PKSF in uthrail branch, where now preparing UMS, UTS & others and selling from their demo place and interested farm holder are buying with low cost but nutritious feed for animal. Its objective to introduce the low-cost technology and to make benefit more to the farmers.

Market Linkage Workshop: MBSK organized market linkage workshop on 20 June 2023 under Livestock unit on Broiler type paking duck rearing that held at MBSK head office-based hall room where participated Livestock farmer owner, Feed seller, Arotder, paiker, retailer, and MBSK concern staff members, total 35 participants. The resource facilitator were Dist. Veterinary Officer, Mrs. Ashika Akbor (Tisa), Dist. Veterinary Surgeon Md. Abdul Jalil and Sador upazila Livestock officer Md. Golam Kibria, Deputy Executive Director. Khaled Mossarof Hossain, Focal person and other concern of the Livestock unit. The objective was to make market linkage of the product.

Establish Sale center of Cutting Poultry Meat: Establish 01 sale center of poultry birds cutting meat as per target in FY 2023-24 and the objectives of the sale center is to make

available of safe and fresh meat for the less income people and to meet up the daily nutritious requirement for the low income groups / less quantity required people.

Field Day: Field Day (Livestock Unit): Mohila Bohumukhi Shikkha Kendra (MBSK) organized 02 Nos. field day under Livestock unit in 2023-24, total 150 members were attended and unit officials, Branch Manager & other staff. The objective of the field day is to highlights the success of the demo to others and motivate to do such activities in the future.

Livestock Consultation Center: Livestock consultation center- 04 & Livestock consultation center- 04 were done at field level (sador -01 branch, Askorpur-01, uthrail-01 and Sankorpur branch-01) and attended 40 participants in each, under Livestock units aiming to deliver technical knowledge and strengthen the ongoing initiative. The participants were demo holders, interested members etc. and discussion were made on livestock rearing issues like- disease, vaccination, feed management, housing etc. The Upazila Livestock Officer and Dist. Veterinary Surgeon were attended in the consultation centers and 40 participants were present in each.

Training: Organized 04 batch training courses on livestock unit (one on uncasted goat rearing-01 batch, Cow rearing-01 batch, and Sonali/broiler birds rearing-02 batches) and each one course for 02 days, during the FY 2023-24 conducted all 04 courses with imparted of selected demo participants. Total 100 participants were received the said training in different date & venue and each course attended 25 participants and topics were on modern technology of livestock concern topics e.g. Duck and poultry rearing, goat and cow rearing, vaccination and about proper management. The external resource person were Upazila Livestock officer and Dist. Veterinary Surgeon, Dinajpur.

Workshop to Honor the Success Farmer /Entrepreneur: Mohila Bohumukhi Shikkha Kendra(MBSK) arranged a workshop to pay honor to the farmer those who are implemented very good/excellent demo in the FY 2023-2024, the workshop was organized in MBSK head office hall room on 21 June 2023, almost 100 participants were attended. The objectives of the program is to give honor to success farmers. The chief guest was Additional Deputy Commissioner, (Education & ICT), Farjana Rahman, Upazila Livestock Officer Dr. Md. Golam Kibria, Sadar, Dinajpur, Deputy Chief Executive Khaled Mosharrof Hossain MBSK, Focal Person Md. Abdul Hakim Miah, unit Livestock Officer & others, provided Crest and cheque of prize money to the success farmers.

5. Learning and Innovation Fund to Test New Ideas (LIFT):

Project starting date: 01-12-2015

Project Area: Uthrail and Shosora union, Sadar, Dinajpur.

Goal and Objectives:

The main goal is to ensure food security and alleviation of the poverty of program participants through increase production of Black Bengal goat with establishing goat reproduction center. Through establishing the reproduction center improve genetic resource and productivity of black Bengal goat by which the hardcore poor and marginal participants will be capable to increase their income and enhance livelihood status sustainable manner. To fulfill the program outcomes purchased 1.27 acre land with the financial support of PKSF in Gosaipur of Uthrail union, Sadar upazila, Dinajpur and the activities are running accordingly.

Goat rearing Credit Support:

Black Bengal goat rearing is a probable and profitable sector for alleviation of the poverty and socio-economic development of participants. The black Bengal goat each year produces kids two times and each time gives 2 - 3 kids and the rural people can easily take care of black Bengal goat. But day-to-day the originality of the variety becomes looser due to lack of proper rearing and preservation. Considering the efficacy of the variety PKSF providing financial support and has taken initiatives for increasing involvement of the rural poor in regards of the semi-intensive method goat rearing. The Organization provided loan (Jagoron, Agrosor, Buniad) in FY 2023-24

to 32 members of amounting to TK. 3,02,672/-.

09. Microfinance program:

Mohila Bohumukhi Shikkha Kendra (MBSK), Balubari, Dinajpur has been working with own initiative from the year 1993 on Savings and Credit activities properly aiming to uplift the economic development of poor people in Dinajpur, Nilphamari, Thakurgaon and Rangpur district. Later from the year 1995 MBSK working with the support of PKSF. At present MBSK have been operating different components of Credit program such as Jagoron (Rural Micro credit), Agrosor (Micro enterprise development), Sufolon (Seasonal loan) program and Buniad (Ultra poor) program, MDF, LRL, MFC, MDP, RAISE, MDP-AF and IGA Goat rearing, Sanitation development with the involvement of poor people. It is mentioned here PKSF supported agriculture based Seasonal loan of which is contributed to agriculture sector. During the group session awareness rising on homesteads vegetable gardening, fish culture, livestock and paddy plantation.

In Bangladesh 10.44% (2022) people live below poverty line which two third of the people are women. The women are not lagging behind. They are being participated for controlling the activities at family, society and also country with equally to the men. Now they are become self-reliant to discharge power. They have overcome of all barriers and moving towards continuously and their impetus /enthusiasm inspired MBSK and accordingly MBSK provided periodic loan(short, mid and long term) with minimum service charge to them for income generation and create employment through different approach. At present MBSK working in Dinajpur, Thakurgaon, Nilphamari and Rangpur District through 30 branches.

MBSK provided micro finance facility to the poor people of the society especially women folk through small group formation for socio economic development as well as for family stability and self-reliant. The organization provided small-scale loan to the poor, helpless and workless people for creating income and small entrepreneur. Banking facilities provided to the poor landless and helpless people both male and female at their doorstep. The poor people of village have got rid of exorbitant rate of interest from village money lender. Due to lack of capital some skilled person did not utilize their efficiency i.e. in animated but revived them.

At present MBSK is working in 927 villages of 189 unions of 21 Upazilas in 4 districts of Dinajpur, Thaurgaon, Nilphamary & Rangpur with 2842 groups with 42158 beneficiaries. Among of them total loan received by 31884 members (female-31360 & male-524).



Mission: Ensure right to food and nutritional security for citizen especially for the poor, marginalized, women and children and it will decline the underlying causes of hunger and poverty.

Objectives:

- 1. To strengthen Right to Food Bangladesh network at local and national level and deepening south Asia region and international process for participation, non-discrimination and empowerment of citizens for solidarity and communicative action.
- 2. To develop and formulate a legal framework and regulatory provisions as right to food law and related national policies for ensuring right to adequate food and nutritional security for all.
- 3. To monitor the social protection program based on NSSS, Seventh Five year plan and SDGs for improved implementation towards achieving the Right to Food.
- 4. To safeguard and ensure the sovereign rights of small holder agriculture, local food producers and communities to the biodiversity, right to work and employment, access to safe and renewable seed and market for sustainable agriculture.
- 5. To monitor and measure the adequacy in a rights-based perspective of land ownership and tenure rights, food safety, food wastage, water rights and consumer protection agencies' legal, regulatory and institutional structures and the mandates of relevant institutions.

16. Mediation and Conflict Resolution Project (Network program):

Men are social being so man position identified through socially. In this society everybody wants to have property assets, exalted dignity and power. In a bid to establish such rights, man sets aside his humanity and conscience, men is taking jealousy, envy depriving tendency. In this way depriving tendency is grown up and a fair and worth living society is adversely hit which results in family feuds and conflicts and the rift family are stepping towards mental and financial loss which is never welfare. The project has been operating to save the people from legal litigations, harassment, time and financial expenses by resolution of family feuds and matters relating to social, economic and poverty related affairs. Consequently, aiming at achieving legitimate rights of women and empowerment, the project has played a vital role in the matters of child marriage, polygamy, divorce, dowry, torture and land related feuds on conflicts through arbitration process. MBSK implementing this program in 04 District (Dinajpur, Thakurgaon, Nilphamari and Rangpur) of 21 upazilas and in group level 2023-2024 done mediation of 2500 conflict at group level(family conflict, quarrel, early marriage, sexual harassment, conflict about land, conflict among husband& wife etc. Through this program to get law assistance to oppressed women 36 oppressed women has referred to BLAST and local police administration, Dinajpur. During the period with the support of BLAST and Deputy Commissioner Dinajpur arranged awareness raising session, seminar and human chain on legal aids where MBSK participated actively. Beyond these through micr-finance program organized mediation meeting under 30 branches.

17. Environment Development Program (Network program):

Environment called around the people's ammunitions and it is treated as pre condition. To survive the people environment should be favorable. At present no fund for available for the program so that MBSK has been working with own initiative for environment development through awareness rising. During the year 2023-24 provided 5000 saplings and planted to different school in Dinajpur Sadar, Birol, Birgonj, Fulbari, beyond these Mst. Sultana Razia Khatum Chief Executive MBSK, planted 10 seeds of palmyra in Shosra union as protection measure from thunderbolt.

Activities:

- Awareness on Health Hygiene and Nutrition * To use Sanitary Latrine
- To use paper bag instead of polythene * Seed and saplings distribution.
- To keep cleanliness of Road, drain and Latrine * Motivate to use Hand tube well/Pump
- To motivate for tree plantation and nursery * Motivation to use of Jute materials.

18. Disable Development program (Network program):

MBSK has been working from the year July 2006 with own initiative for the development of the persons with disability. MBSK identify the problem of disable and enlisted the disable person among them some are physically handicapped, sight, intellectual and mentally impaired. By this time MBSK maintaining communication and support with 336 numbers disabled persons for their mental courage. In the future if the support will be available from Donor MBSK will undertake the activities for their development. The Chief Executive of MBSK is a member of Disable development network and regularly attended in the meeting.
